<b>Further Information for Students</b>	<a href="#">Welcome to study in Kajaani - Opiskelijan Kajaani</a>  Please note that students must be prepared to cover their living expenses according to the guidelines provided by the Finnish Immigration Service (Migri). This means having at least €800 per month available for living costs, which totals €9,600 for the first year. These funds must be separate from the tuition fee – the money reserved for living expenses cannot be used to pay the tuition.  Students should also be prepared to cover their expenses for at least two years and should not rely on finding a job quickly after arriving in Finland. Employment opportunities may be limited, especially at the beginning of the studies.
